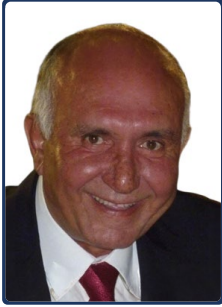

Finally, I wish you all a pleasant stay in Dubai.

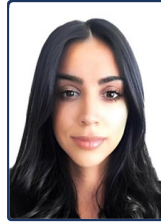

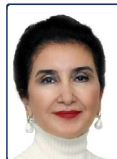
