DIGITAL POSTER PRESENTATION ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Digital Poster Abstract Submission Guidelines:

- The outline must have an Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- All Accepted abstracts for posters must be <u>accompanied by a complete conference</u>
 <u>registration form with payment</u>.
- For any withdrawals, the presenter should notify the *organizer in writing at least <u>2 weeks</u>
 before the event.
- The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract.
- The participant must be registered at **Dubai Derma Conference & a Confirmed Digital Poster Participant** in order to be included in the final conference booklet.
- Co-authors will receive a notification letter to acknowledge their abstract participation signed by the Conference Chairman.

Digital Poster Display Format and Presentation Guidelines:

 Digital Poster (Artwork) should be in **Portrait format** submitted as one piece as per the below specifications. (Other sizes or dimensions will not be accepted)

Dimensions: 2160*3840

Width: 2160 pixels | Height: 3840 pixels

Horizontal Resolution: 96 dpi | Vertical Resolution: 96 dpi | Bit Depth: 24





- Digital Poster Format: JPEG
- The Poster format should include Introduction, Objectives, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- Poster Title: 30 font size in Arial Black Body Text: 25 font size in Arial with single spacing.
- Do not use all UPPER-CASE characters in your posters.
- The images (clips arts, graphs, diagrams, and drawings) must be in high-resolution EPS format (300 dpi).
- 49-inch LCD screens will be provided at the poster area.
- All Digital Posters should be emailed to v.satish@index.ae on or before the 10th February
 2025.
- All Digital Posters will be on display for the duration of the conference.
- Digital Poster finalists will receive an email in advance to prepare for their presentation.
- All Digital Posters finalists should be ready to present their posters at the poster evaluation time which will be communicated with them before the event.
- Digital Poster Finalist will be allotted a 2-3 minutes short introduction with the judgers followed by a 2-3 minutes discussion.
- Judges will be available to select the three winners during the poster evaluation time.
